The dedication of England to Our Lady is captured in the 'Wilton Dyptych', which is exhibited in the National Gallery. In the left inner panel the kneeling King Richard II is presented by the Saints John the Baptist, Edward the Confessor and Edmund the Martyr.

NB: Every effort has been made to find the earliest foundation dates for the Shrines listed in this presentation



When was the first recorded dedication of England to Our Lady?

King Richard II dedicated England to Our Lady after the Peasants' Revolt at Smithfield on 15th June 1381, by making the following proclamation throughout the land: "Dos tua pia haec est, quare leges, Maria" - *This is Your Dowry, O Pious Virgin Mary*. England therefore belongs in a special way to the Blessed Virgin, who is the country's protectress and who, through her intercession, acts as the country's defender and guardian.

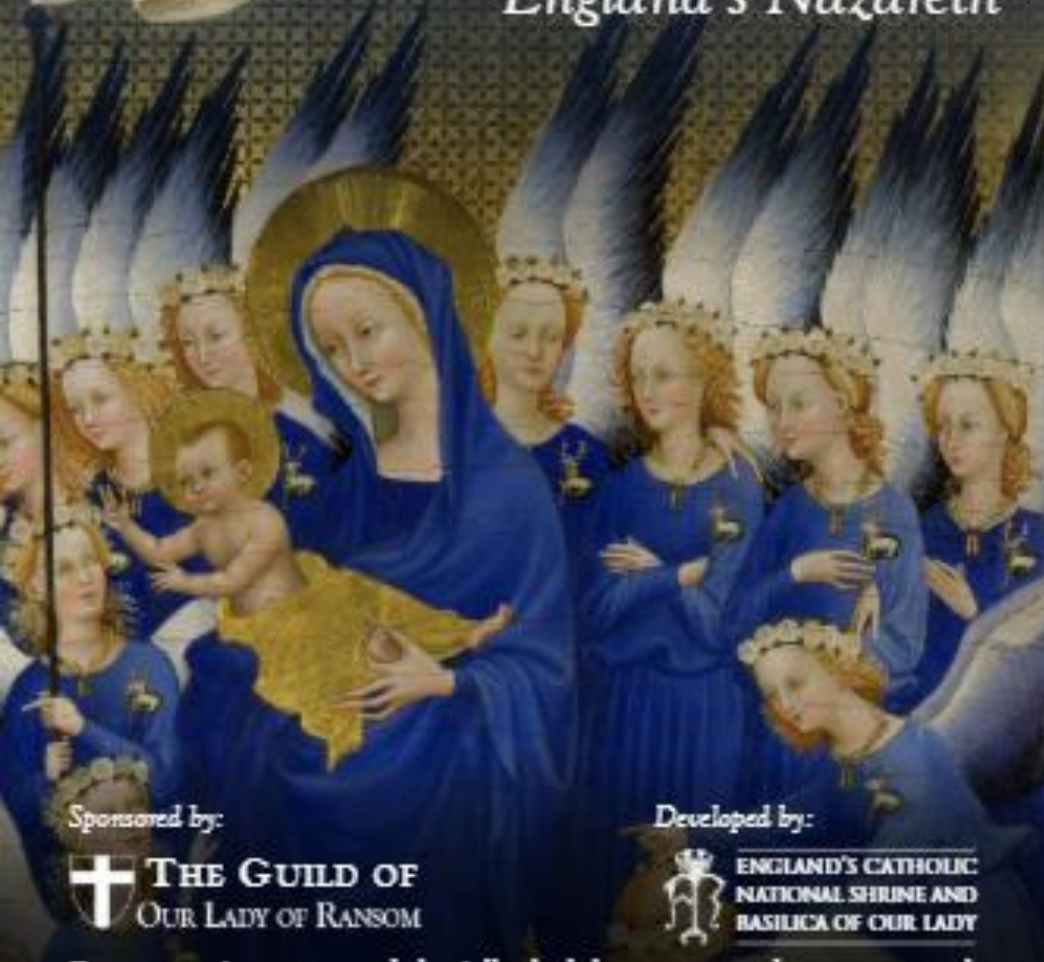
