














#### Re-dedication - 30<sup>th</sup> March


- 21<sup>st</sup> Feb: Start of 33 days of personal consecration to Jesus through Mary
- **18<sup>th</sup> March:** Statue of Our Lady of Walsingham will go to Parliament for Mass and the Rosary. We pray for wisdom for law-makers in the UK at this time
- 19<sup>th</sup>-22nd: Statue of Our Lady of Walsingham is in Westminster Cathedral for the Dowry Pilgrimage. Schools are invited to attend on the afternoon of 20<sup>th</sup> March.
- 25<sup>th</sup> March: Feast of the Annunciation
- 26<sup>th</sup>-28<sup>th</sup> March: Triduum (3 days) of prayer focussed on Eucharistic devotion
- 29<sup>th</sup> March: Rededication of England as Mary's dowry in parishes
- **30<sup>th</sup> March:** Rededication of England as Mary's dowry in schools











## Call: Pray for us, holy Mother of God,









The dedication of England to Our Lady is captured in the 'Wilton Dyptich', which is exhibited in the National Gallery. In the left inner panel the kneeling King Richard II is presented by the Saints John the Baptist, Edward the Confessor and Edmund the Martyr.

#### When was the first recorded dedication of England to Our Lady?


King Richard II dedicated England to Our Lady after the Peasants' Revolt at Smithfield on 15th June 1381, by making the following proclamation throughout the land: "Dos tua pia haec ese, guare leges, Maria" - This is Your Dowry, O Pious Virgin Mary. England therefore belongs in a special way to the Blessed Virgin, who is the country's protectress and who, through her intercession, acts as the country's defender and guardian.
