



Jesus knew what brings real happiness so he taught us how to be truly happy or 'blessed'.

He did this when he spoke to a large crowd on a mountain.

It is called 'The Sermon on the Mount'.

He taught us about 8 attitudes which are called the **Beatitudes.**

> Blessed are the merciful, for they will be shown mercy. Blessed are the pure in heart, for they will see God. Blessed are the peacemakers, for they will be called children of God. Blessed are those who are persecuted because of righteousness, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

During the Sermon on the Mount, Jesus 'gave' us the Beatitudes.


'Blessed are the peacemakers for they will be called children of God.' Matthew 5:9

What does the word "peace" mean? Look at these actions Which would you place under **Peacemaker**?




How can my eyes, the way I look at people, bring peace and love?




