



The Beatitudes The Beatitudes are a beautiful collection of sayings by Jesus. They sum up his teaching about what it means to live as a child of God's kingdom. They can be found right at the beginning of a long teaching discourse by Jesus in Matthew's Gospel, known as the Sermon on the Mount. One of the ways that Matthew presents Jesus is as a kind of 'new Moses.' So, just as Moses taught the people of Israel from the mountain after he had received the law, so Jesus begins his ministry by going up a mountain and teaching his disciples.



When Jesus saw the crowds, he went up the mountain; and after he sat down, his disciples came to him. Then he began to speak, and taught them, saying:

'Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

Blessed are they who mourn, for they will be comforted.

Blessed are the meek, for they will inherit the land.

Blessed are they who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they will be satisfied.'



'Blessed are the merciful, for they will be shown mercy. **Blessed are the pure of heart, for they will see God. Blessed are the peacemakers, for they will be called children of God. Blessed are they who are persecuted for the sake of righteousness**, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.'

The sixth beatitude tells us...

Blessed are the pure of heart, for they will see God. Matthew 5:8
