Depending where you are on the leadership scale and where your school is, Head teacher salaries can range from £60,261-£139,891.

Being a head teacher is a fulfilling and exciting way of knowing that you are making a difference to children's lives and educating our next young Catholic congregations. But it can also be stressful and lonely at the top. All our headteachers are matched with an experienced mentor from our Diocese in order to provide them with friendly back up and support.

We run an induction programme for each new cohort of new heads, putting them in touch with each other and giving them the chance to share their experiences and worried with each other.

New Heads are supported in their local deanery groups and by participating in our annual conference.

We run network meeting for our growing number of CEOs of Catholic multi- academy Trusts and support the NPQEL.

There are often opportunities for heads to work collaboratively with each other informally, or to provide school to school support and executive head model.
