

Into Leadership

Pay for senior leaders can differ dramatically based on the size and location of a school. In inner London, a deputy may earn between £57 000 and £77 000, but this would be less without London weighting.

Anyone looking to move into a head or deputy head role in a Catholic school must be a practicing Catholic. All applicants applying for these roles will need to be able to name their Parish Priest as a referee to attest to their practice. This requirement is laid out in the [Bishops' Memorandum](#)
