The leaders of tomorrow's schools are in our schools today. We need young Catholics to enter teaching so that the next generation of young people get to understand what it is to live our faith- not just learn about it in RE lessons. We want to instil the ethos of our schools in them so that, whatever profession they enter, they take what they have learned with them. We know that many of our students are passionate advocates of the principles of Catholic Social teaching at school- let's keep that going as they enter the workforce.

We cannot assume that pupils in our schools will naturally progress into teaching unless we actively promote it as a career and a vocation within the Church. Schools can cover teaching in a Catholic school as part of the Core RE delivery.

Schools should make sure that teaching is promoted at internal careers fairs. 3 of our Trusts currently run teacher training programmes.
